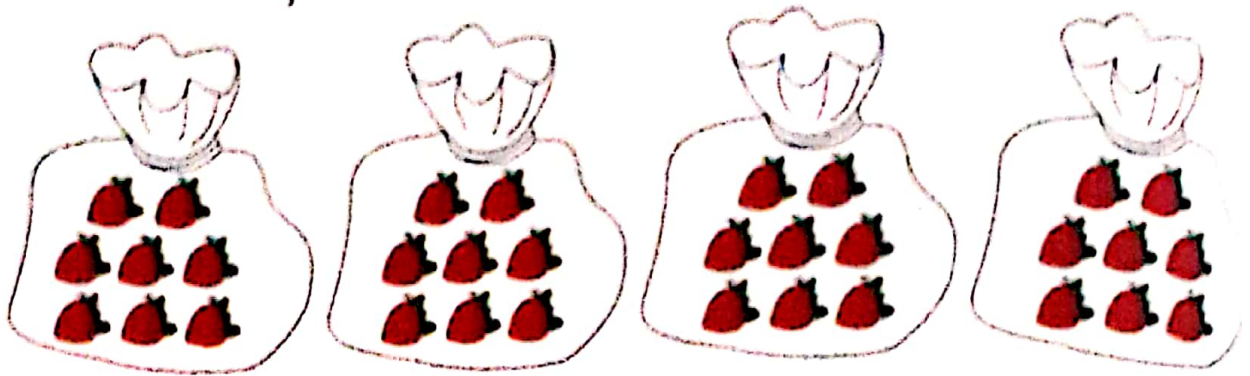


3. Sharon buys 4 bags of strawberries. Each bag contains 8 strawberries. How many strawberries does she buy in all?



$$4 \times 8 = 32$$

She buys 32 strawberries in all.

4. The apples are arranged in groups of four. How many apples are there altogether?



$$9 \times 4 = 36$$

There are 36 apples altogether.

Fill in the boxes

1. There are 7 bags of doughnuts. Each bag contains 3 doughnuts. How many doughnuts are there altogether?



$$7 \times 3 = 21$$

There are 21 doughnuts altogether.

2. A cable car can carry 5 people. How many people are there in 5 cable cars?



$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

There are 25 people in 5 cable cars.



## Word problems

1. There are 5 trays. Each tray has 3 glasses of milkshake. How many glasses of milkshake are there altogether?



$$5 \times 3 = 15$$

There are 15 glasses of milkshake altogether.

2. Jack has 2 boxes of seashells. Each box contains 7 seashells. How many seashells does Jack have in all?



$$2 \times 7 = 14$$

Jack has 14 seashells in all.

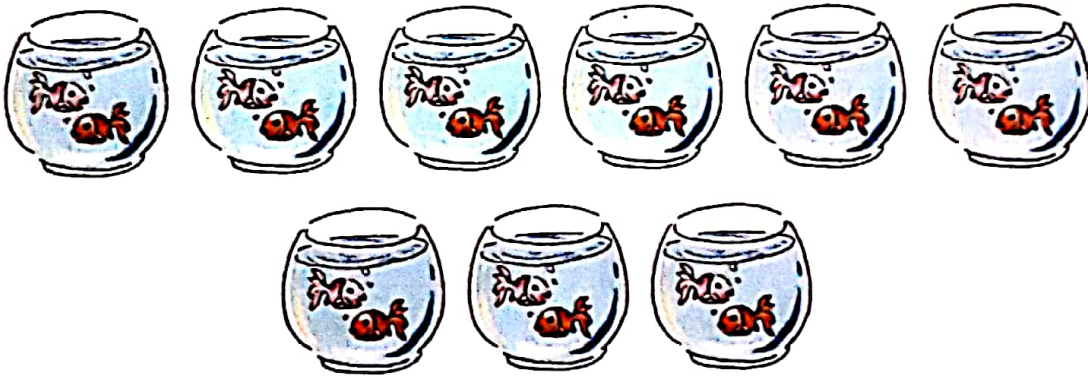


5 groups of 4
