Question Answer

Q.1. What is the favor of Allah to mankind over other creature and what is its value?

Ans. Allah favored man over other creatures by giving him the power of expression and the capacity to understand.

Question Answer

Q.1. What is the way of true guidance?

Ans. Devotion to the Sunnah of Prophet Muhammad (SAW), the rightly guided Caliphs and his companions, is the only way of true guidance.

Q.2. What is the way of salvation when to find difficulty in the following true path?

Ans. The Prophet (SAW) predicted that disagreements and difference within the Ummah will become so common that people would find difficulty in following the true path. In that critical situation devotion to the sunnah of Prophet Muhammad (SAW) and the practices of the rightly guided Caliphs is the means of salvation.

Q.3. What is the definition of Bid'ah?

Ans. Bid'ah or Innovation (invention) in matters of religion, i.e. new addition to religion is called Bid'ah. People have introduced many practices into Islam which were not practiced or approved by Prophet Muhammad (SAW) and his companions.

Q.4. What are the dangers of Bid'ah?

Ans. Bid'ah or Innovation (invention) in matters of religion is a serious and dangerous matter. Prophet Muhammad (SAW) said "Beware of new additions to religious affairs, for every new addition is an innovation and every innovation is misguidance, and every misguidance is in the Fire."

Q.5. What are the basic principles mentioned in this hadith?

Ans. This hadith includes some basic principles of life and warnings.

Fear of Allah is the highly virtuous quality that is manifested by performing righteous deeds and keeping away from forbidden acts. Obedience to the ruler or guardian within the limits of the Shari'ah is mandatory upon Muslims. Disobedience to the rightly authorized ruler is an act of serious sin because it creates confusion and disorder in society or the state.
