- 1.What is the religion of the Khasi?

Ans: The Khasi worship several gods, among whom the father is 'Ublei Nangthau', creator of the earth.

Ans:Garo society is traditionally matriarchal, which means that the mother is head of the household and the women inherit the family property.

- 3.Write about the society of the Khasi.

Ans: The Khasi society is matriarchal, but the youngest daughter inherits the family property. They are an agricultural society, which specializes in growing betel leaves and cultivating bees.

Ans: The main festival of the Oraon is 'fangua' which is celebrated on the last day of Falgun.
