(The farewell Address)

Q1. What was Khutbatul wadaa?

A. Khutbatul wadaa was the farewell speech of prophet Muhammad (SAW) delivered at Arafat before about 120,000 of his followers.

Q2. What is the significance of Khutbatul Wadaa?

A. Khutbatul wadaa is one of the most memorable speeches in the history of Islam and mankind. The prophet delivered this speech sitting on a Camel on Jabalal rahma in the valley of Arafat and in the imparted? Advice and instructions to his followers.

Q3. What was the revelation which came at that time?

A. The relation that came on the day of the farewell speech to prophet is that Allah has perfected our religion for us and completed his favours upon us and had chosen Islam as our religion.

Q4. Why did prophet (SAW) ask the people to bear witness regarding his mission.

A. Prophet (SAW) asked the people of the congregation whether he has conveyed the message to them and he invoked Allah 3 times to be witnessed to this to confirm that he has fulfilled his duty as a prophet.

Q5. Mention 2 important points from the farewell speech of prophet Mohammad (SAW)?

A.

1. All the dues of Riba stand cancelled and people shall take only their capital back.
2. Prophet said he is learning behind the Quran and his Sunnah and if you follow this you will not fail. Worship Allah, offer Salah and observe the fast in the month of Ramadan and give Zakah.

(Visiting the prophet's Mosque)

- Q1. Why do Muslims like to visit Madinah?
- A. Muslims like to visit Madinah as it is a sacred city which is the destination of prophet's Hijrah and the Centre of Islamic learnings.
- Q2. What should be the intention when visiting Madinah?
- A. The intention of visiting Madinah should be to pray in prophet's mosque and to send durood and salaam to the prophet.
- Q3. Mention a hadith related to Masjid al-Nabawi?
- A. According to Masnad Al-Ahmad prophet said don't take my grave as a place of celebration, just send your salaam upon me and our salaams will reach me where ever you might be.
- Q4. How does a Muslim visit the prophet's grave?
- A. When someone is present at Masjid-al-Nabawi, he may visit the prophet's grave and send salaam to him, then he should say salaam to Abu Bakr as-Siddique (RA) and Umar-al-Farooq (RA) whose graves are next to that of the prophets' grave.
- Q5. What are other places in Madinah that can be visited by the Muslim?
- A. Muslims may also visit the grave yard of Al-Baqi, they may visit the graveyard of Martyrs of Uhud and they should visit Masjid-al-Quba to pray there.
