Q. 1. What is the meaning of Du'aa?

Ans. Du'aa is an Arabic word which literally means invocation, supplication, prayer and appeal to Allah for oneself or on behalf of another.

Q.2. What is the Importance of Du'aa in Islam?

Ans. Du'aa is one of the most important forms of Ibadah. It is regard as one of the greatest acts of Ibadah. Muslims are instructed to supplicate to Al-mighty Allah. Allah urges us always to invoke Him for our needs and requirements.

Abu Hurairah (RA) reported that Rasulullah (SAW) said: Nothing is more honorable in Allah's sight than Du'aa. (Muslim)

Ans. 1. The realization that only Allah the Almighty , responds to du'aa.

2. Sincerity in du'aa to Allah the Almighty, alone.

3. Performing tawassul properly

4. Not being impatience

5. Making du'aa for good things

6. Having the right intention

7. Having in attentive heart

8. Purity of one's sustenance

9. Observing priorities

Q.4. What are the appropriate times and places for making du'aa?

Ans. There are some special times and special places which make response to one's du'aa most likely. These times are : (1) after the adhan and after obligatory prayers, (2) during tahajjud, (3) in Ramadhan and (4) during the days of tashriq in Hajj. The places are: Masjid al- Haram at Makkah, Mina, Muzdalifah, 'Arafah, al-Masjid an – Nabawi at Madinah and al – Masjid al – Aqsa at Jerusalem.

Ans. Abu Hurairah (RA) reported that Rasulullah (SAW) as saying: Three du'aas are answered there being no doubt about them: The Du'aa of one oppressed, Du'aa of a traveler and Du'aa of a parent (At Tirmidhi Abu Dawood)
