These three crimes are especially detestable, and the penalty for them will be doubled – humiliation will be added to physical punishment.

Q.2. What did Allah say about the punishment of a person who kills a believer intentionally?

Ans. Allah mentioned in His Holy Qur'an: And whoever kills a believer intentionally, his recompense is Hell, to abide therein eternally; and the wrath of Allah has come upon him and His curse, and a great punishment has been prepared for him. (4:93)

Q.3. How long a believer remains within the scope of his religion?

Ans. Prophet (SAW) said, A believer remains within the scope of his religion as long as he does not kill anyone unlawfully (Al – Bukhari)
