Q.1. Where did the people of Aad live?

Ans. According to the Qur'an, the people of Aad lived mainly in the Ahqaaf region, which is situated to the southwest of the Empty Quarter, between Hijaz, Yemen and Yamamah. The people of Aad spread and established themselves in Oman, Hadramawt and Iraq.

Q.2. What type of people were the Aad?
